## Group Obedience Class Information

**Wednesday Evenings**  
**October 9th– November 13<sup>th</sup>**  
**\$110 for 6 weekly classes**

**Puppy Training:** 6:00 p.m. For puppies 3 to 6 months of age. Socialization, Attention, Walking on Leash, Sit, Down, Come, Manners, Playtime with Confidence Course. Bring small, soft, yummy treats, or the kibble that you feed your pup.

**Basic Obedience:** 6:30 p.m. For Beginning dogs 6 months of age and over. Learn how to teach your dog basic Control and Good Behavior, based on the AKC Canine Good Citizenship (CGC) program. Heeling, Come, Sit, Down, Stand, Stays, Problem Solving, Appropriate Behavior with other dogs/people, and more.

**Basic 2 & Rally Combo:** 7:30 pm. Continuing Obedience skills. Learn how to keep your dog's attention while having fun working together as a team. Heeling, Recalls, Stays, Fronts, Finishes and more. Rally skills and runs will be included. Basic obedience or equivalent training is a prerequisite.

**Registration:** Will be taken the first night of class, October 9th. Arrive ½ hour prior to the start of your class to fill out your paperwork. Vaccination records required. If possible, Leave dog in car while you register.

**Enrollment cost** for all classes is \$110 for 6 weekly lessons held Wednesday evening

- Cash or check only, Payable to SJDTTC
- One-time Spay or Neuter Discount of \$5 off any class with veterinary certificate
- One-time Rescue Dog Discount, with paperwork – 50% refund upon class completion
- Youth 12 – 16 years of age - \$55, any age dog, any class.

Please no handlers under 12 years of age, must be physically able to control their dog.

**Location:** 5111 W Sargent Road, Lodi Ca 95242 (on the grounds of Sycamore Lane Kennels Facilities) All classes Indoors in climate controlled building. Rally or "Come When Called" training may be outdoors in a fenced area weather permitting.

**What to bring for your dog:** **Leash-** leather preferred, but nylon or cotton web are okay. **Collar:** Buckle, Martingale, Slip chain, or prong; A harness does not work well for training. **Treats** for rewards: soft, small, tasty pieces, and/or a toy.

**Vaccinations:** All dogs must have current DHPP, Bordetella, & Canine Flu vaccinations. All dogs over the age of 4 months must have proof of Rabies vaccine. Please bring all proof of vaccinations on veterinarian letterhead the first night of class. **Do not bring a dog to class without proper proof of vaccinations.**

### Sycamore Lane Kennels Facility Rules

- ~Park your car in the lot in front of the training building only. No Parking by the kennel entrance area, grooming, or play area.
- ~Keep your dog on short leash, quiet, and under control at all times. Stay far enough away from others to prevent any aggressiveness. Dogs that are strange to one another may stress when crowded together that first night.
- ~No dogs are allowed around the pond, adjacent grass areas, pool, homes, or kennel office area.
- ~Potty Area: in gravel area near training building restrooms; pooper scoopers and garbage cans are available there. You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog in class or anywhere on the grounds.
- ~Respect the privilege of using these lovely grounds, drive slowly, especially in front of the houses.
- ~No cash refunds. If your dog or you become injured or ill, we will credit the unused portion towards a future class.
