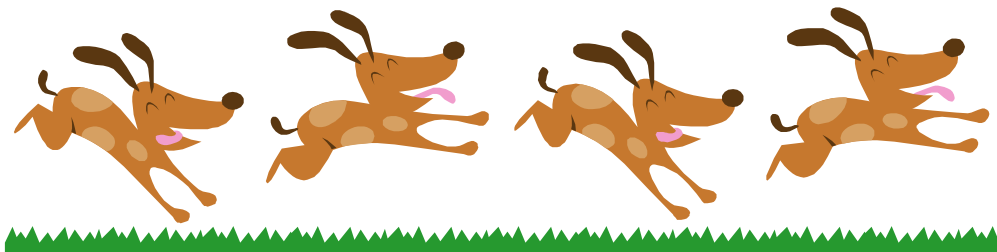

IMPORTANT CHANGES – PLEASE READ

1. **Entries are limited to 65 handlers or 120 entries, whichever limit fills first.**
2. **Printed catalogs will be available only upon request. *Check the box on the entry form if you want a printed copy.* There is no charge for the catalog for exhibitors, but you must request one.**
3. **There will be no morning hospitality or lunch provided. Please bring your own food and water.**
4. **The raffle has been cancelled for this trial.**
5. **Cash prizes are not offered for class placements this year.**
6. **Masks are required in the rings, the bathroom, and any place where you might walk within 10 feet of other people. Be safe, keep everyone safe, keep it on unless you are at least 10 feet away from everyone outside your immediate family (who are hopefully staying home today).**
7. **You will be asked to sign a waiver of liability that must accompany your entry (see page 8)**

Wait List - SJDTC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 10 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to September 2, 2020, 5:00 pm. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on September 2, 2020, 5:00 pm. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.



Refund for bitches in season: The club will retain a \$6.00 processing fee.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

Every precaution for the safety of dogs and exhibitors will be exercised, but neither the Club nor the management will be responsible for loss or injury.

Exhibitors are asked to refrain from bringing family and friends that are not showing dogs. This is to minimize the number of people on the trial site during the pandemic.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

All dogs must be **ON LEASH** at all times while on show grounds and parking areas unless in the ring for judging. There will be pooper-scoopers available. You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Consult the judging schedule for the time of judging. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club assumes no responsibility for this.

CATALOG ORDER: As far as is practical, all entries will be arranged according to jump height, in descending order for all obedience and rally classes that require jumps.

In case of a tie for an award, a dog not present for a run-off will forfeit the right to the award.

NO AWARDS WILL BE MAILED.

Print or type entries carefully, using **BLACK** or **BLUE** ink. The Club accepts no responsibility for incorrect or illegible entries. Entries that are received unsigned, without the proper entry fee or without both sides of the form, will not be accepted.

No entries can be changed or refunded after the closing date.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including, but not limited to, extreme heat, snowstorms or hurricanes) or any other act beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. **Entries will be refunded only if the trial is cancelled due to Covid19.**

Acknowledgement of receipt of entries will be made soon after closing date. **Confirmations and judging schedule will be emailed only.** Please include your email address on your entry form. Should such acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor five days prior to the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

COVID-19 BEST PRACTICES

1. Participants are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event.
2. You will be required to wear a mask while in the ring while competing with your dog. You may not enter the ring if you are not wearing a mask. You must bring your own mask!
3. Parking – leave at least one vehicle space between vehicles.
4. Practice physical distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
5. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others.
6. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
7. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
8. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color/black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
