## JUDGING TIMES

**Judging times will be given after entries close**

Ribbons/Awards will be given out at the trials.

**Move Ups transfers WILL be accepted up to 5:00pm the day before each trial!**

## DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor or shredded. Please make sure we can read your entry! Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

## STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

**Staging Area** will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

## SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

**Search Area Conditions.** Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

## ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. This trial site will not be used for Scent training one week before the trial.

**Possession of Odors and Training.** Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

**Spectator Area.** Spectator areas will be left up to each judge. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

**Crating space** will not be available. Please crate your dogs in your car. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

### Reactive dogs

**Chapter 3 Section 30. Special Accommodations for Certain Dogs.** *Clubs are not to make special accommodations for certain dogs (such as dogs determined by their owners to be "reactive"). Clubs may not advertise a "red bandana" policy in Premium lists or printed materials or impose such a policy in the briefing.*

## RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement rosettes will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place Rosette.....	Blue
Second Place Rosette.....	Red
Third Place Rosette.....	Yellow
Fourth Place Rosette.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

\*A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

\*A New Title elite ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a elite title.

\***Super Sniffer Dog Tags** – Pass all 4 elements at any one difficulty level and receive a Super Sniffer Dog Tag. (all 4 element must be offered and passed at any one difficulty level to be eligible)

### High in Trial - Rosette

Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered for that level and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Trial. One High in Trial winner is chosen from the Novice (A & B are the same class), Advanced, Excellent & Master classes if two or more classes are offered at that level.

The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's times across the elements. The faster-finishing team will win. If there is a tie the winner will be determined by a flip of a coin. Teams without faults take priority.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website.

## PARKING

Through the Lake-Drake Cluster

Day of Show parking - \$10 per day or \$30 a four day pass. When entering the grounds, tell the parking attendants you are with the Scent Work trials. This will allow you to park in the back near the Scent Work trials so that you will be able to work from your vehicle.

**OVERNIGHT PARKING**  
**Provided and facilitated by Lake-Drake Cluster.**

Overnight vehicles, those with passes and exhibitors, enter the Expo Gate from E. Gum Avenue. NOTE: Main Gate to the grounds closes promptly at 10:00 pm. With absolutely no admittance after that time.

**Advanced fee- \$55.00 per night. Overnight begins at 4:00 pm. Please check below which night(s) you are staying. There will be a \$20.00 charge for all returned checks.**

1. Tag-along/tow vehicles - \$30.00 flat fee (must fit in your space).
2. Any payment at gate must be in cash at a fee of \$70.00 per night and must be for the balance of the weekend. NO EXCEPTIONS!
3. All RVs using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from the dogs and people. Quiet Time: 10:00 pm – 6:00 am.
4. 20 amp Electrical hookups for \$10.00 per day if available – include payment below and indicate how many nights.
5. Wednesday parking hours: 12:00 pm – 10:00 pm.
6. All overnight parking must be inside the gate by 7:30 am on show days or else wait until after Best In Show judging to park. (will have to go in Main Lot and pay a fee and wait).
7. Gates open at 6:00 am Thursday, Friday, Saturday, & Sunday and close at 10:00 pm Thursday-Saturday. No overnight parking on Sunday. Grounds must be vacated one hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
8. Reservations close Wednesday, August 28, 2024, after which time there will be no cancellations or refunds

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The San Joaquin DTC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The San Joaquin DTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the San Joaquin DTC or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. Pinch collar, Electric collar, and any other collar not allowed by AKC regulations are not allowed on the grounds. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Videoing of any search area may not be posted to Social Media without the land owners permission. Video is for personal use only. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

### REFUNDS

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

### RINGSIDE

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

**Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
