**If you are entered in a class that includes a jump, you must specify your dog's jump height on the entry form.**

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor or shredded. Print or type entries carefully, using BLACK or BLUE ink. The Club accepts no responsibility for incorrect or illegible entries. Entries that are received unsigned, without the proper entry fee or without both sides of the form, will not be accepted.

Acknowledgement of receipt of entries will be made soon after closing date. Confirmations and judging schedule will be sent by email only, so please include your email address on your entry form. Should such acknowledgement of receipt of entry not be received by an exhibitor five days prior to the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary. No entries can be changed or refunded after the closing date.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except for waitlist provisions), nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including, but not limited to, extreme heat, snowstorms, or hurricanes) or any other act beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**Bitches in season:** Full refund will be given for bitches in Season after the closing date. You must request a refund in writing to receive a refund. The request must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

**Wait List** - SJDTC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries prior to the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **15 entries** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial's closing date/time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after the trial's closing date/time. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, the original entry and check will be shredded. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will have the original entry and check shredded.

**Move-ups:** Move-ups will be allowed at these trials per AKC Regulations.

## **OBEDIENCE AWARDS**

First Prize..... Blue Flat Ribbon  
Second Prize..... Red Flat Ribbon  
Third Prize..... Yellow Flat Ribbon

Qualifying Score in each class..... Green Flat Ribbon

Highest Scoring Dog in the Regular Obedience Classes..... Blue & Gold Rosette  
Highest Scoring Dog in Open B & Utility B Combined..... Blue & Green Rosette  
New Title Ribbon will be awarded for any dog completing a title ..... Rosette

In the case of a tie for an award, a dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit the right to the award.

**Ribbons:** No Ribbons will be mailed. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award.

**Catalog Order:** As far as is practical, all entries will be arranged according to jump height, for all Obedience classes that require jumps.

## **GROUND RULES AND TRIAL PROCEDURES**

Crating of entered dogs will be allowed in the building if these rules are followed:

- Please put a **CLEAN** towel and/or **CLEAN** mat under your **CHAIR and CRATE** to protect the matted surface and keep it clean.
- NO X-pens in the building.
- NO crate aggressive dogs in the building.
- A dog not entered in the trial is not allowed in the building.

NO overnight & NO day of RV parking.

NO smoking allowed on the grounds.

You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Every precaution for the safety of dogs and exhibitors will be exercised, but neither the Club nor the management will be responsible for loss or injury.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

All dogs must be **ON-LEASH** at all times while on show grounds and parking areas unless in the ring for judging. Retractable leashes (Flexileads) are permitted, **but not to be extended beyond 6 feet in length indoors.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Consult the judging schedule for the time of judging. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club assumes no responsibility for this.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. - Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
